Afterschool Alliance COVID-19 Tracking Program Provider Survey - Waves 1-5 Comparison

Topline survey results are based on four online surveys conducted by Edge Research. Wave 1 was conducted May 28-June 30, 2020 of 914 program providers representing more than 6,000 program sites. Wave 2 was conducted July 20-August 31, 2020 of 1,047 program providers representing more than 7,600 program sites. Wave 3 was conducted September 28-October 27, 2021 of 1,445 program providers representing more than 7,300 program sites. Wave 4 was conducted February 19-March 15, 2021 of 1,235 program providers representing more than 6,400 program sites. Wave 5 was conducted June 2-28, 2021 of 937 program providers representing more than 6,400 program sites.
