

Afterschool Alliance COVID-19 Program Provider Survey

Waves 1-7 Comparison

Topline survey results are based on seven online surveys conducted by Edge Research. Wave 1 was conducted May 28-June 30, 2020 of 914 program providers representing more than 6,000 program sites. Wave 2 was conducted July 20-August 31, 2020 of 1,047 program providers representing more than 7,600 program sites. Wave 3 was conducted September 28-October 27, 2021 of 1,445 program providers representing more than 7,300 program sites. Wave 4 was conducted February 19-March 15, 2021 of 1,235 program providers representing more than 6,400 program sites. Wave 5 was conducted June 2-28, 2021 of 937 program providers representing more than 6,400 program sites. Wave 6 was conducted November 1-December 13, 2021, of 1,048 afterschool program providers representing more than 9,800 program sites. Wave 7 was conducted March 21- April 12, 2022, of 948 afterschool program providers representing nearly 5,500 program sites.
