HOW TO GET INVOLVED

First, sign up to join our <u>Earth Day tweetchat</u> (get the details below). We'll send you an email reminder in the days leading up to the chat to make sure you don't miss it—and to share the names of the expert partners who will be joining us.

We also encourage you to explore our collection of <u>environmental education resources</u> to get inspiration for your program—and share your favorites on social media.

If your program already offers environmental education, we want to hear from you throughout April!

- Share photos or stories on social media to give a firsthand look at the impact environmental education can have, and how it can be implemented in an afterschool setting.
- Have resources or curricula in mind that helped you implement your environmental education programming? Share them to help other afterschool programs get started.
- Join our Earth Day tweetchat to share your experiences and hear from environmental education experts.

HASHTAGS

TWEETCHAT

On April 22 at 2PM Eastern Time, we'll host an hour-long conversation on Twitter for afterschool programs and environmental education experts to come together and share insights and resources to help grow environmental education in out-of-school time spaces.

Never joined a tweetchat before? No problem. It's simple: We'll ask a series of open-ended questions over the course of the hour, and several partners will be on hand and ready to answer. If you have your own answers to share, jump in and respond to as few or as many questions as you want! You can also participate by asking follow-up questions or otherwise engaging with our expert partners and other participants.
