

# Afterschool Alliance COVID-19 Tracking Program Provider Survey

## Wave 1, Wave 2, and Wave 3 Comparison

Topline survey results are based on three online surveys conducted by Edge Research. Wave 1 was conducted May 28-June 30, 2020 of 914 program providers. Wave 2 was conducted July 20-August 31, 2020 of 1,047 program providers. Wave 3 was conducted September 28-October 27, 2021 of 1,445 program providers.
